

Drama Key Stage 3 Curriculum

In Year 7, students begin with an introductory unit using games and exercises to develop co-operation skills, voice and movement foundation skills to build on in future work. They then go on to explore a number of different play texts and styles of theatre such as Greek Theatre, developing specific drama techniques.

In Year 8, the first unit is Power of Women where students explore the theme of women as role models, developing their own original monologues for presentation to an audience. Year 8 students then take part in a series of practical sessions learning about different genres of theatre, developing their knowledge and understanding of a range of performance styles.
