Governors' Allowances & Expenses Policy

Governors should not be out of pocket as a result of serving on the governing body. EGA governing body believes that paying governors' allowances, in specific categories as explained below, is important in ensuring equality of opportunity to serve as governors for all members of the community.

Although governors cannot be paid for attendance at meetings, the following expenses are admissible:

- Child care or babysitting expenses
- Care arrangements for an elderly or dependent relative
- Support for governors with special needs (e.g. audio equipment)
- Support for governors whose first language is not English (e.g. translations)
- Telephone charges, printing
- Travel and subsistence whilst on school business

Claims should be made using the same process as outlined in the School Expenses Policy.
